*Medical Electrical Equipment—Part 2-23: Particular Requirements for the Safety, Including Essential Performance, of Transcutaneous Partial Pressure Monitoring Equipment* (Adopted IEC 60601-2-23:1999) ..... \$60

This standard specifies requirements for the safety, including essential performance, of transcutaneous partial pressure monitoring equipment, whether this equipment is standalone or part of a system.

It applies to transcutaneous monitors used with adults, children and neonates, and it includes the use of these devices in fetal monitoring during birth.

It does not apply to hemoglobin saturation oximeters or to devices applied to surfaces of the body other than the skin (for example conjunctiva, mucosa).

## Formal Interpretations

---

The following interpretation regarding CSA standard CAN/CSA-B339-96, *Cylinders, Spheres and Tubes for the Transportation of Dangerous Goods*, Clause 9.2.1, has been approved by the Technical Committee on Cylinders for Transportation of Dangerous Goods.

**Question:** Does the ultrasonic testing described in Clause 9.2.1 of CAN/CSA-B339 apply to starting stock that is sheet or plate?

**Answer:** No.

The following interpretation regarding CSA standard CAN/CSA-B339-96, *Cylinders, Spheres and Tubes for the Transportation of Dangerous Goods*, Clause 3, has been approved by the Technical Committee on Cylinders for Transportation of Dangerous Goods.

**Question:** Does the definition "A lot of TC-4LM cylinders would be all identical, length, thickness, and diameter, cylinders of a model made in a calendar month where all cylinders produced use the same heat number of heads, the same heat number of shells, and the same heat number of welding wire" comply with the definition of "lot" in Clause 3 of Standard B339?

**Answer:** No.
